



## Youth Anglers Requirements

April 26, 2019

The following Rules to be considered or not considered as a Youth Member to participate in any Event in Kayak-Anglers will be determined by the age of any individual(s) age at the date of their own Individual Membership Registration date

At the day of Individual Member Registration, any Member that has already reached the age of 18 years of age will NOT be considered a Youth Member and will not be required to sign the Release of Liability Form to participate in any Kayak-Anglers Event

At the day of Individual Member Registration, any Member that has not reached the age of 18 years of age, That Member will be considered a Youth Member for that Season and must have Parent or Guardian who has signed the Release of Liability Form to participate in any Kayak-Anglers Event

At the day of Individual Member Registration, any Member that has reached the age of 16 years of age will be permitted to be a Solo Angler, without a Parent or Guardian within the range specified to the Under 16 years of age Rule, but, Must have Parent or Guardian who has signed the Release of Liability Form to participate in any Kayak-Anglers Event

At the day of Individual Member Registration, any Member that has not reached the age of 16 years of age, That Member will be required to be within 100 yards of the Parent or Guardian who has signed the Release of Liability Form to participate in any Kayak-Anglers Event

At the day of Individual Member Registration, any Member 12 years of age or younger will be required to be in a Tandem Kayak or Canoe with the Parent or Guardian who has signed the Release of Liability Form to participate in any Kayak-Anglers Event

Age 3 (or 35 lbs) to 12 – Must be in a tandem kayak with a parent or guardian, and parent or guardian must sign an Acknowledgement & Assumption of Risk Form for each child. Age 13-15 – May be in a solo kayak, but must be accompanied by a parent or guardian on the water. Must also have parent or guardian sign an Acknowledgement & Assumption of Risk Form. Age 16-17 – May be in a solo kayak on water alone, but parent or guardian must sign an Acknowledgement & Assumption of Risk Form. Age 18+ – Must sign an Acknowledgement & Assumption of Risk Form.

With respect to rules, our goal is to ensure a safe event for everyone. Anglers who do not adhere to the rules above will be disqualified.

ADDITIONAL NOTE: Junior members are permitted to receive assistance from a fellow competitor while measuring their catch. If the competitor agrees to help, he or she may take the photo while the junior member holds the fish on the board with both hands. Please note, all other measuring rules apply. The photo may be taken and submitted to the system by a device that belongs to either the junior angler or the competitor who is providing assistance.
